Violation #13. Food in good condition, safe, & unadulterated
At the time of this inspection, 4 cans of Evaporated Milk were observed expired (11/22/2023). Discard products. Person in charge discarded the products. A note of stop sale notice was created. Corrected Onsite.
CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(1). The food packaging shall not be compromised nor the true appearance, color, or quality of a food be intentionally altered.

Violation #15. Food separated & protected; Single-use gloves
At the time of this inspection, raw meet was observed mixed with raw chicken inside the walk-in freezer. Food products shall be organized inside the reach in refrigerator and cooler based on cooked temperature. Inspector Hernandez explained the corrected method to Person in charge. Person in charge removed the chicken. Corrected Onsite.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). Foods shall be stored and handled to prevent cross-contamination. Raw animal foods shall be separated from RTE food and from other raw animal food during storage, preparation, holding, and display. Single-use gloves shall be used for only one task and purpose and discarded when damage occurs or the task is interrupted.

Violation #54. Garbage & refuse disposal
At the time of this inspection, the Dumpster was observed open. Dumpster shall always be closed to prevent rodents and contamination. Person in charge closed the Dumpster. Corrected Onsite.
CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Garbage shall be disposed of to prevent vector harborage. Trash cans will be durable, cleanable, leak proof, insect and rodent resistant, and non-absorbent. Outside storage area shall be of a smooth, non-absorbent material and sloped to a drain.

Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, & clean
At the time of this inspection, one of the handwashing sinks was observed out of service. Work order # 4391747. Repair or replace handwashing sink.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.

Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting
At the time of this inspection, a jacket was observed in the kitchen (preparation table). Provide personal space for personal items. Person in charge removed the jacket. Corrected Onsite.
CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.
